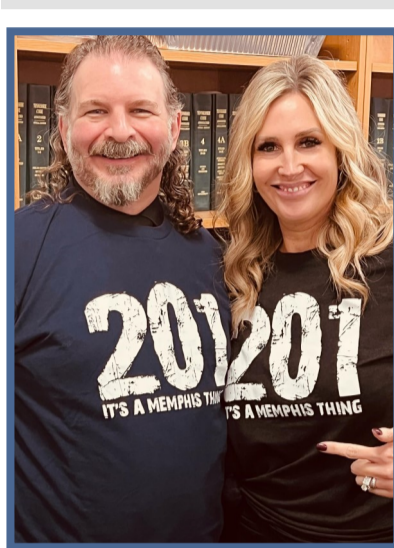

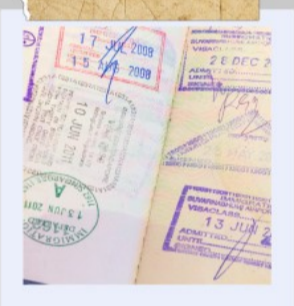
## CONGRATULATIONS CLERK KUHN

# Bertha Hardaway

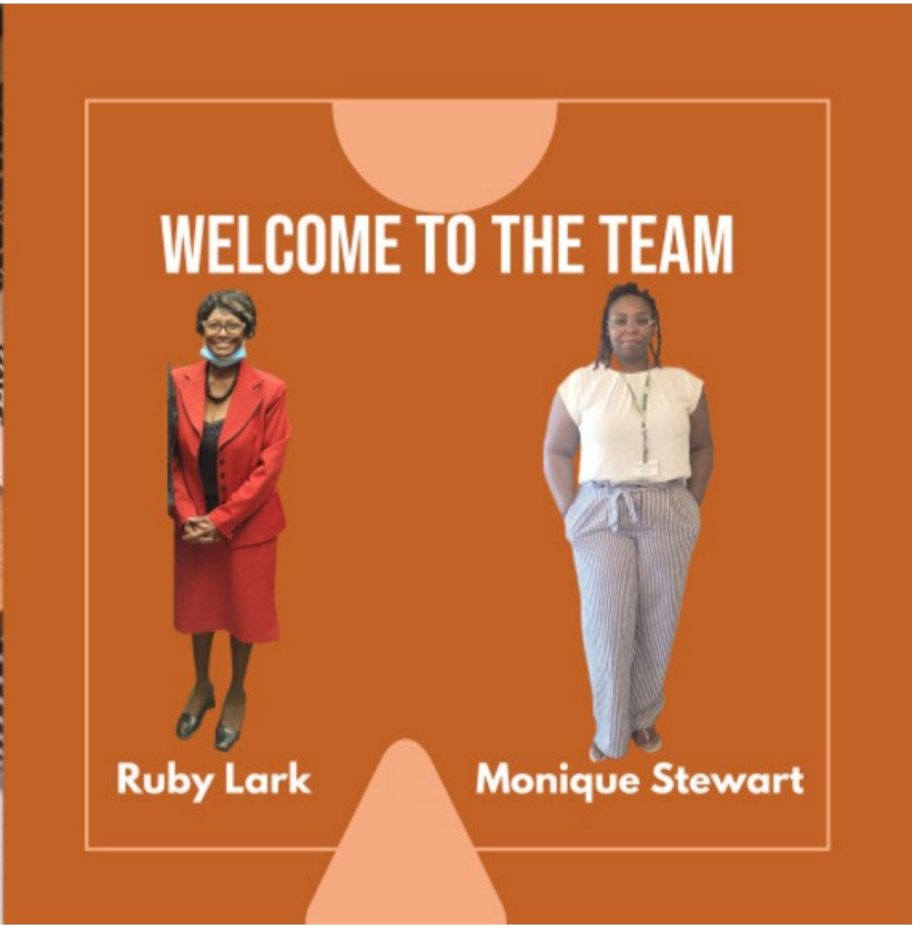

Ms. Hardaway is looking forward to retiring and traveling the country.

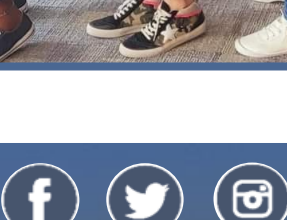
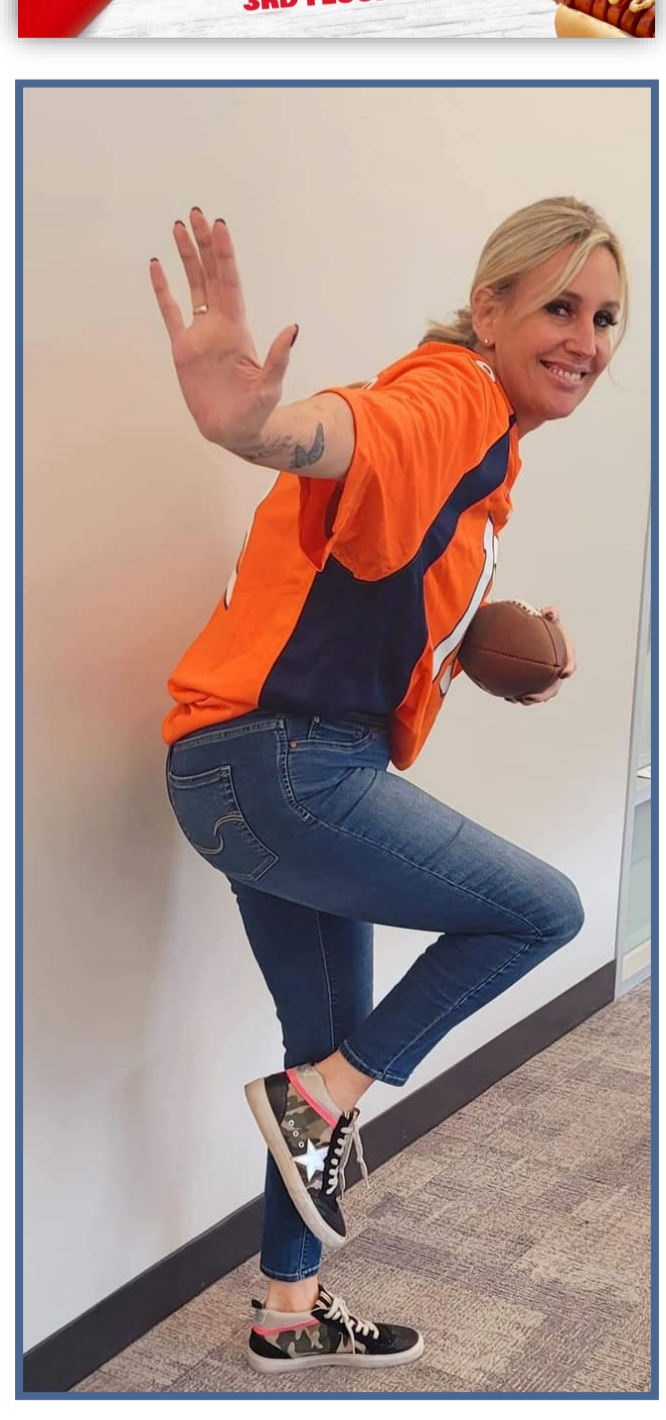
